



# Dyeing One-Off Pieces of Fabric

We will be dyeing cotton fabric with fibre-reactive dyes. Basic dyeing will be covered but the main emphasis will be on creating weird and wonderful one-off pieces using simple shibori (fold and stitch resist) techniques

### **Requirements for each student**

- Old clothes or an apron, an old towel
- Dust mask (from hardware store)
- Rubber gloves (long washing up ones, not disposables – you will be delving into the buckets)
- Packet of large ziplock plastic bags
- 1 one cup measuring jug
- 1 two-litre measuring jug
- Large plastic spoon for stirring
- 1 plastic bucket
- Plastic kitty litter tray or similar (e.g. Large ice-cream containers – several if possible)

### **None of this equipment should be used for food preparation afterwards**

- At least 5 metres of white 100% cotton fabric washed in hot water and detergent (ironing is not necessary)
- You may also like to bring some printed fabric for over dyeing.
- Large needle and strong thread
- Scissors (not your good ones)
- Note book, biro and pencil
